

Fall 2013 Rules and Discipline Activity

Matters Decided with Hearing

CALV 17/2 (2 hearings) – Sitting out coach went to game & for at least 20 minutes watched from sideline, and placed at least one cell phone call to game day coach about whether a particular player was there. Game declared a forfeit & coach suspended for 3 games.

In later game where coach was serving suspension, team started game with 10 players against opponent with full compliment plus substitutes, and after going down 4-0 parents pulled players, manager as acting coach acceded, and advised it was out of concern for safety. Committee disagreed. Suspended coach for 2 additional games, manager banned from coaching in coach's absence, and team fined \$400.

T AFC 13/2 – Team used ineligible guest players in first 3 games of the season. In the fourth game, opponent complained before game. Committee was unable to conclude with comfort whether guests were used in fourth game. Game results for fourth game set aside & game will be replayed in its entirety. First 3 games declared forfeit & coach suspended for 3 games.

Matters Decided Without Hearing

Disciplinary Decided by Clubs with R&D Concurrence

Coach/Team Official

Ejected Coach/Team Official Fails/Refuses to Leave Field or Returns Immediately After Game

LOUD 19/2 – Ejected coach fails to leave field despite request by referee, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

LFC 16/5 – Ejected coach doesn't leave field and continues dissent, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

BFC 16/6 – Ejected assistant coach returns to field after game to confront referee, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

RUSH 14/3 – Ejected coach returns to the field after game, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

CALV 12/1 – Ejected coach returns to field after game, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

FRED 12/9 – Ejected coach doesn't leave and confronts referee after game, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

Failure to Properly Serve Sit Out

LMVS 19/3 – Sitting out coach at game, suspended for 2 games in addition to sit out still owed. Since team lost, game results not impacted.

MRM 14/4 – Sitting out coach at game, game declared a forfeit, coach suspended for 2 games in addition to sit out still owed.

Using Players in More than One NCSL Game on Same Day

LMVS U10 – With coach out of town, assistant coach uses some players in two NCSL games on same day, suspended for one game.

CALV U9 – With coach at another field, the assistant coach uses some players in two NCSL games on same day, suspended for one game.

Exceeding Game Day Roster Size

WSC 16/6 – Team brings and plays 19 players, game declared forfeit & coach suspended for one game.

Players

Misconduct After Ejection

WBSC 19/3 – Ejected player engages referee after ejection, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

SYC 14/1 – Ejected player engages assistant referee with abusive language, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

Violence

NVSC 19/3 – Player throws punch at opponent, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

REST 17/4 – Player holds opponent in strangle hold, suspended for one game in addition to red card sit out.

Affiliates

SYC 14/1 – Affiliate who engages assistant referee and uses obscene gesture, banned for 1 game.

CALV 13/7 – Affiliate who confronts referee in threatening manner, banned for 3 games.

BETH 12/2 – Ejected affiliate who returns after game to confront referee, banned for 2 games.

ASA 12/2 – 3 affiliates confront referee during and after game, banned for 1 game.
